Chairperson's Report June 2025

Another month has flown by, and it has been great to see some fine weather. Everyone is enjoying their bowls and soaking up the sunshine. Club championships are in full swing and well done to the committees for accommodating everyone on the one green.

A big thank you to the Morton Bay Council for repairing the pipe that caused the sinkhole in the Kling Green. We are awaiting another quote for fumigation from a

South Australian company, so when that is finalised, we can schedule the refurbishment. Unfortunately, the refurbishment grant we applied for cannot go ahead as the result of our application may not be available till January which will be too late for us. However, we do have other avenues of inquiry regarding grants and donations and have just received notification from Busy Fingers that they will donate the \$36443.00 to cover the major costs. This is great news and is a direct result of the hard work done by our Board Secretary Marilyn Weston. Thank you, Marilyn.

The refurbishment will be in 4 major steps over the coming months.

- Step 1 scalping of 60mm off the top of the green
- Step 2 fumigation of the green to get rid of the Ground Pearl
- Step 3 laser levelling and aeration
- Step 4 planting of sprigs and fertilising.

Many of you may have heard there is a new rumour doing the rounds now of the club being kicked out and the building demolished in two years' time. As with the RSL and CPS, we are still operating under the Facilities Hire Agreement. That was re-signed in 2017 so is up for renewal in 2027. We have a tenyear option in place after that so we will not be asked to leave. Rumours have always been rife, so if anyone is not sure of anything please ask for clarification from a Board member.

For those members not enjoying good health, I wish you well and a speedy return to the Greens.


ACKNOWLEDGING THE GENEROSITY OF BUSY FINGERS








### **Appreciation to our continuing sponsors**


#### WINTER CARNIVAL
