Chairperson's Report September 2025

As we know the Kling Green has now been laser levelled and the fumigant Basamid applied to eradicate the remaining ground pearl. We now await the Basamid to dissipate so the sprigs of Tif Dwarf can be planted. The Richardson Green has also been aerated, with little effect on bowls. This will improve the overall health of the green, and allow the chemical Scarlett Trio to penetrate deeper as applications continue over the coming months.



The water stained ceiling tiles in the clubhouse are being replaced as required by sheets of coreflute. It's a good alternative as the original tiles are not available anymore. Many thanks to Graham Symonds for his efforts in obtaining, cutting and installing these new tiles. Along with the servicing of the air conditioners and the carpets being cleaned, the clubhouse has a "new clean" feeling about it. Also, thank you to the members who removed the furniture to allow the carpets to be cleaned, then put it all back.

RUOK day was once again a tremendous success. A big thank you to Rod Curtis and his team of dedicated volunteers in making it a great day. Our club is truly blessed in having so many willing helpers and you all contribute in making us "The Friendly Club". The feedback from Remax and their guests was very positive. No Rollups/Practice from **10am to 11am from Friday, 10th Oct, for 6 weeks** due to the U3A coaching course.







Thank you to the bar staff for keeping everyone hydrated and thanks go to our ladies committee for putting on a great fun night. Again, feedback has been extremely positive.


So, save up, and in a few months we will run another Trivia night with the theme “Yet to be decided”. When the date is provided please put it on your calendar for another fun, friendly night.
